amining your face at night, because after sleeping the face retains liquid, producing a deceptive widespread appearance to lines and wrinkles.

Through his practice, Dr. Silich strives to enhance natural beauty, rather than create an artificial appearance. Believing in the eastern design philosophy of Wabi Sabi, Dr. Silich holds that there is an inherent beauty in slight imperfections. His philosophy is that less is truly more for plastic surgery, and he never suggests excessive over-correction, as patients may lose traits that are innate to their family.

Board certified by the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, and a member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons and the American Society

of Aesthetic Plastic Surgery, Dr. Silich also serves as a Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery at Cornell University Medical College, instructing students in the plastic and reconstructions surgery residency programs at New York Presbyterian Hospital in New York City. Dr. Silich is also an attending surgeon at New York Presbyterian Hospital, Lenox Hill Hospital, and the Manhattan Eye, Ear, and Throat Hospital. Additionally, in June 2008, Dr. Silich was named iAssociate Directori of The Burn Center at North Shore LIJ; Staten Island University Hospital, and was just selected again by New York Magazine in 2009 as one of its iBest Doctorsii in the area of plastic surgery.
